 - An Uncheck Device and mouth pieces
 - Consultation forms (remember you can add data directly to PharmOutcomes if you have an Internet access in your consultation room)
 - \circ $\,$ An SOP Signed off by your Superintendent $\,$
 - A fully completed and signed copy of your Declaration of Competence stored in your pharmacy
 - All you then need to do is brief your staff, put up your posters and send the briefing to your local practices.
