Designated Supervisors and DPPs must have appropriate experience and training to act effectively as educational supervisors.

## Top tips

- **Number of trainees:** Plan the number of foundation training posts
- **Partnerships & Collaboration is key:** Develop relationships for multi-sector rotations: : Local GPs, Hospital, Acute trusts
- **Agree a placement fee:** Swapping trainees vs placement fee
- **Flexibility to design your programme:** Make it work for your organisation and your trainees
- Prepare training site submission for Oriel deadline - **1<sup>st</sup> March 2024**

## Top tips

- **Think long term planning:**
  - Funded Independent prescribing
  - Develop prescribing services
  - Develop supervision skills
  - System level working

## NHS Training Offer




- NHS England will provide access to a consistent, funded training offer in the foundation training year, which will be available to all foundation trainee pharmacists across all sectors and regions.
- **Basic Training Includes:**
  - Induction Day to orientate trainees to the programme
  - Establishment of communities of practice for trainees, to provide additional support to develop their prescribing practice (currently under exploration)
  - Online learning materials to support delivery of the Learning Outcomes
  - First Aid training

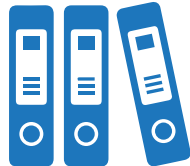

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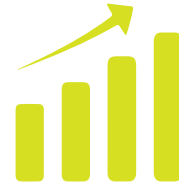
