How to stay on top of referrals

Good record keeping is key. We have a board within the pharmacy which is used to track every patient's journey. This means that we can see at a glance which patients are in hospital as well as which have now been discharged and will now need their medication.

Top tips to help you succeed



Maintain good relationships with surgeries and hospitals

Identify key contacts at the GP and hospital to regularly check in with and get updates around a patient's prescriptions requirements and whether they have been discharged.

Assign overall responsibility

Selecting one person within your team who will take overall responsibility for the service and for checking PharmOutcomes helps reduce the chances that something is missed. To cover holidays and absences it's useful to also have a deputy.
