Dear Pharmacists

I am writing to you as your pharmacy is signed up to our locally commissioned service (LCS) stop smoking contract, which involves supplying nicotine replacement therapy (NRT) to clients of Be Well Tameside and Tameside Maternity Tobacco Dependency Team.

<u>From 1st November 2024</u> - Tameside Maternity Tobacco Dependency Team will use PharmOutcomes to request NRT, so from this date you will no longer receive NRT request letters.

PharmOutcomes will automatically generate a combined invoice for you. We will therefore **only be accepting manual invoices for NRT that has been requested by letter up to and including 30th November 2024**. Please ensure you have sent any outstanding claims to <u>publichealth.enquiries@tameside.gov.uk</u> by <u>31st December 2024</u>. After this date, any outstanding claims will not be paid.
