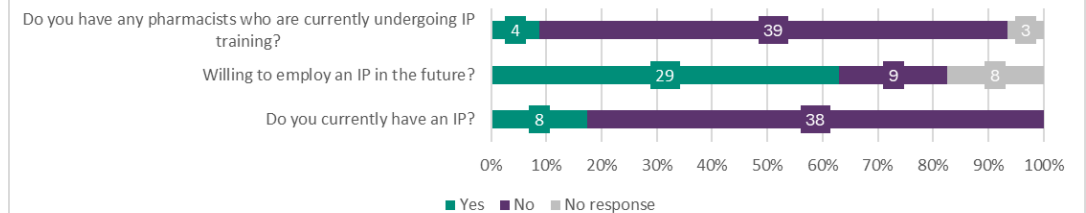
Wheelchair access
